Minutes

Prior to the board meeting, the 2022-23 "Support Employees of the Year" were honored with a reception and program. Each school nominated a support employee and certificates were awarded to these individuals by Superintendent, Dr. Lewis Brooks and Assistant Superintendent and Chief of Staff, Mr. David Calhoun. A video presentation was shared with the audience of the top 5 category winners: Sophia Melton, Instructional Paraeducator, Calera Elementary; Wayne Estress, Maintenance Technician, Calera High; Celia Hooks, Human Resources Secretary, Central Office; Julie Hughley, Bookkeeper & Office Manager, Montevallo High; Sue Brown, Custodian, New Direction; and Stan Hubbard, Bus Driver, Oak Mountain High School/Transportation Department.
