<u>DESCRIPTION</u>: The Monroe Thrift Shop Association offers the opportunity to apply for a one—time only scholarship to all graduating seniors of Monroe County High Schools and Monroe County home-schooled graduating seniors. The objective of this scholarship is to help provide post-secondary training for a young man or young woman who shows promise in terms of general aptitudes and personal qualities.

CRITERIA:

- 1. The applicant must give evidence of sufficient potential to justify advanced training in a field in which the applicant is interested.
- 2. The student must be of good character and have a good citizenship record.
- 3. The student must show financial need. Such need will be assumed to exist if, without the scholarship, a student taking advanced training would be a serious strain upon the family or cause a student the need to engage in an excessive amount of self-support work.
- 4. If a recipient should receive a full tuition scholarship to a college, the recipient must forego this scholarship.
- 5. The student must be accepted for admission in an institution offering acceptable advanced training in the field in which the applicant is interested.
- 6. The applicant must register as a full-time student.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD: This scholarship, in the amount of \$1,000, must be used toward semester fees or books for the 2023-2024 school -year in any institution offering acceptable advanced training. Applications for Monroe County Community College, four year academic institutions, as well as vocational/trade schools will be accepted.
