Weatherization Assistance Program



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- weatherization services are provided to households with an annual income at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty
- Homes that have not been weatherized in the last 15 years.
- All houses will have to pass a preinspection.
- Home owners and renters can both



WHAT'S THE PROCESS?

- Apply to the program and receive approval that you are eligible.
- An energy evaluation of your home will be performed.
- Certified contractors

 add energy efficiency

 and safety

 improvements to your
 home.
- A Quality Control inspection is done to ensure correct installation.



THINGS TO KNOW:

- It's a FREE program funded by the US
 Department of Energy.
- This is not a home repair, remodel, or rehabilitation program.
- Only measures with direct energy savings or associated health and safety, as determined by the audit, can be installed.
- Income qualification does not guarantee work will be done.
- Homes can not be for sale, in foreclosure, or in remodeling.



WHAT SERVICES CAN I RECIEVE?

- Depending on the inspection, official software will determine what can be done to improve your home's energy efficiency.
- Possibilities include:

 Wall, attic, & foundation insulation, furnace repai or replacement, air leakage reduction, dryer venting, carbon monoxide/smoke alarms water heaters, and refrigerators. (This is no an all inclusive list.)


