FIRST DAY CHECKLIST

PARENT PORTAL

Parent Portal is a link for parents to check on a student's attendance and grades. Access to the parent portal can be found on the school website under the Parents dropdown menu. Usernames and passwords can be obtained by contacting your child's school office. Once an account has been created it will follow the student from year

to year. You will receive updated alerts through this system. We encourage you to set up an account.

STUDENT HANDBOOK

Student handbooks serve as a valuable resource for students and parents alike. Students and parents are encouraged to become familiar with the policies, procedures, rules, and regulations. If you have a specific concern that is not adequately or clearly addressed within these documents, you are encouraged to contact your child's principal, counselor, or teacher.

SCHOOL NURSE

The goal of each school nurse is to ensure every student has a healthy and productive lifestyle during their time in school. We strive to keep each student healthy. If your child has any underlying health conditions or illness, it is imperative that you notify the school nurse before attending school.

TRANSPORTATION (Car/Bus Riders)

School operating hours are from 7:30 a.m.- 3:30 p.m. Do not drop off any student before 7:30a.m. Please make sure you have notified your child's campus of the transportation method your child will use such as a bus rider or car rider. On the elementary campus, each home room teacher will have a chart as to what bus # each student rides, and please notify the school should this change. If your child is riding a bus to or from school, please note that transportation could run early or late due to unforeseen circumstances. We ask if you need to make transportation changes during the day, please do so before 2:30p.m. so arrangements can be made. Bus riding is a privilege and can be taken away from the student. If you have questions after school hours, the district has someone on staff until 4:30 at the Elementary; that number is 936.872.3315 ext.300.

FOODSERVICE DEPARTMENT

Both breakfast and lunch are free to every student. You still need the school lunch forms

filled out in order to appropriate coding to the state.

The cafeteria staff strives to promote a safe and healthy environment for our students and maintain the state guidelines for a well-balanced, nutritional diet. It has been proven, students are able to learn better when they are well-nourished.
