All Physics & Chemistry students must have a **calculator (Graphing for Physics)**.

CALCULATOR - *Every child in high school math must have his own calculator. Please, if you don't have the right kind and are purchasing one, buy the suggested model. Do not buy a bigger, better model. It is easier for us to teach a classroom full of kids with all the same calculators. The fancier ones have some functions we do not want the students to have. If you buy a different model, we do not have the time to figure out how to run it and may indeed refuse to let him use it.*

There are two models that we use. The TI-30 (or TI30XA or TI30S) which costs about \$10.00. The TI 83+ costs about \$95.00. They can be purchased at Wal-Mart, Best Buy, Staples, etc.

Do not buy a TI 85, TI 89, or TI 92. These models have functions we do not want our students to have.

Algebra 1A, 1B - TI 30 OR TI 83 (83 is preferred)

Math Survey, Geometry - TI 30 is fine

Algebra I, Algebra II, Trig and Stats, PreCalc, Transition - TI 83+

Math I/II/III/IV - TI 30 is fine

If your child is in a class that requires the TI83+ but you already own a different graphing calculator like a TI 82 or a TI 83, do not buy a new one. It will do just fine.

If your child is in a class that requires the TI 30 and you already have a calculator with cos, sin, and tan, do not buy a new one. It will be just fine.

If your child needs a TI 83+ but you do not wish to purchase one, they can be rented from the office for \$25.00 per year. That is probably a good idea if your child is not going to use it for multiple years. Of course, if it is lost or broken, you will have to pay the replacement cost as you do for the lost textbooks.
