**General items needed for both 7 & 8 Grade Classes**

Lead #2 pencils, blue or black pens, highlighters, glue stick, tape, scissors, colored pencils and 2 boxes of Kleenex for your first period teacher's classroom

**7 Grade ~ English / Reading**

A one (1) inch 3-ring binder dedicated solely to Reading & English, or must have space in a larger 3-ring binder with divided sections and a Bic 4-color pen that has red, green, blue and black ink all in one pen

**8 Grade ~ English / Reading**

A one (1) subject wide-ruled notebook, a folder/binder and a Bic 4-color pen that has red, green, blue and black ink all in one pen

**7 & 8 Grade ~ Science**

One (1) - One subject spiral or loose leaf notebook and a folder with pockets for use ONLY in Science class

**8 Grade ~ Physical Science**

One (1) large spiral notebook and a folder with pockets for use ONLY in Physical Science

**7 Grade ~ World Studies**

One (1) One subject spiral or loose-leaf notebook and a folder with pockets for use ONLY in World Studies

**8 Grade ~ American History**

One (1) large 100-200 page spiral notebook, a folder with pockets for use ONLY in American History

**7 Grade ~ World Studies**

One (1) - One subject spiral or loose leaf notebook and a folder with pockets for use ONLY in World Studies

**7 & 8 Grade ~ Math / Math Plus**

One (1) folder with pockets, loose-leaf paper and 4 dry erase markers

**8 Grade ~ Algebra**

One (1) – 2 inch binder with loose leaf paper, 4 dry erase markers and a TI-30XIIS calculator

**7 & 8 Grade ~ Phys Ed**

Shorts, a shirt, tennis shoes are needed daily for class (Any items students already have can be used)

**7 Grade ~ Health**

1 (one) One subject spiral or loose-leaf notebook and a folder with pockets for use ONLY in Health class

**7 & 8 Grade ~ Band**

Standard of Excellence Book 2 (blue book) for your instrument, a sharpened pencil, and a 1" binder.
