Are you a licensed child care center?



QRS is a voluntary program for licensed childcare centers, designed to recognize, support and increase the quality of childcare throughout Louisiana. QRS simply means our teachers are observed more frequently by an outside source and we have higher standards than regular licensed centers. We currently hold 3 stars in the program. What does this mean to you? This means you are sending your child to a higher standard preschool. By doing this, a tax credit becomes available to you and your family.



Are your teachers certified?

Our preschool staff is 100% CPR and First Aid certified.

We also have teachers who are certified through
Louisiana Pathways. Our certified lead teachers have a
Child Development Associate (CDA) Credential, an
Associates Degree in Child Development or an Ancillary
Teaching Certificate through the Louisiana Department of
Education. We believe your children deserve the best
quality care. Therefore, we believe hiring qualified staff will
ensure our teachers have all the skills they need to teach

your young learners.



What are your hours of operation?

Monday-Friday, 6:45AM-6:00PM

We have an open door policy with flexible hours. This allows you to drop-off or pick-up your child at a time that best fits your family's schedule.

We strive to have our facility open as much as possible for our working parents, yet still allow our staff to have time with their families during the holidays. Therefore, we observe and are closed on the following holidays:



New Year's Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and the following day, Christmas Eve and Christmas Day



What age can my child start attending Claiborne Christian Preschool?

We accept children as early as 6 weeks old and continue educating children until they go into Pre-Kindergarten.

We believe young children are like sponges, soaking up every verbal and nonverbal interaction. Therefore, we take every moment we have with our young learners to teach, train and educate them socially, physically, academically and spiritually.



Is Claiborne Christian Preschool aligned with a specific denomination?

Claiborne Christian Preschool is not directly associated with a denomination. Our sponsoring church, Family Church, is a member of the Church of God, Cleveland, TN. We are intentional about creating an atmosphere that is welcoming to children from a wide variety of denominations.



What is taught during Chapel?

Our Chapel time focuses on the redemptive story of the Bible. The curriculum intentionally walks students through the Bible teaching them the key principles, stories and truths. However, we do not teach any church doctrine.

During chapel your child will experience an interactive, engaging lesson that captivates the youngest learners. Your child will also get the chance to participate in praise and worship during their chapel experience.



What supplies do I need to bring for my child?

Our hope at Claiborne Christian Preschool is to make your morning as simple as possible. We know how difficult it can be to get yourself out the door and remember to bring all the supplies your child will need while you're away. Therefore, the curriculum and supply fee supplies all of the items your child will need throughout the year. (ex. Crayons, colored paper, nap pad, nap pad cover, blankets, etc.) Breakfast, lunch and snack are provided for all of our children along with all baby food and formula for our infants.



Parents are responsible for bringing the following items:

Infants: diapers, water, bottles and extra clothes
Toddlers: diapers/pull-ups and extra clothes
Two Year Olds: pull-ups/underwear and extra clothes
Three Year Olds: extra clothes



How do I monitor my child throughout the day?

We currently use the Brightwheel app for daily updates and communication. Brightwheel will track their food intake, nap and potty schedule, learning activities along with pictures, videos and much more. This will also be how you will sign your child in and out of our facility on a daily basis.

We also have an app for you to download called GV-EYE. This will give you live camera feed of your child's classroom for you to view at your desired amount. This can give great comfort to you knowing that you are able to view your child throughout the day.
