As a small school, Ellsworth Community School is always seeking new and innovative ways to deliver rich curricular choices to our students. For the past eight school years, we have been operating our "Lancer Leap" program all ECS students.

This three-week project based term, which takes place in May, provides two unique and innovative opportunities for us as a district. First, it allows us to offer hands-on elective opportunities for our students that cannot be accomplished within a traditional curriculum. Second, it provides remediation options to students whose achievement scores are not at grade level, and/or to allow students who have failed courses the opportunity to recover credits without needing to repeat classes.

The curricular goals and objectives of Lancer Leap can be summarized in four C's; Communication, Creativity, Critical Thinking, and Collaboration. Thanks to our wonderfully talented and flexible teaching staff, we are able to challenge and inspire our students in ways that are not always possible in other districts.

In 2013, the Michigan Association of School Administrators recognized Lancer Leap by awarding us their prestigious Winner's Circle award for innovative programming.
