Dear Chief Justice Rush:

This morning, the Board of School Trustees of the Plainfield Community School Corporation voted to provide \$20,000 in annual funding over a five-year period to jointly establish and operate a pilot youth assistance program with the Town of Plainfield and Hendricks Superior Court Judge Karen M. Love, and to enter into an interlocal agreement with Hendricks County and the Plainfield Town Council.

Our goal is to provide early intervention with at-risk juveniles, ideally keeping them as students in good standing and reducing the likelihood they will enter the juvenile justice system. Our hope is that the pilot program will be successful, so it may be replicated throughout Hendricks County and Indiana.

We are aware that the Indiana Senate has encouraged the state's juvenile court judges to create voluntary preventative programs for at-risk children and authorizes the creation of pilot programs. We would welcome the opportunity to develop one of those pilot programs. Thank you for your consideration of our request.
