A regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees of the Plainfield Community School Corporation, Hendricks County, Indiana, was held in the administration building of Plainfield Schools at 985 Longfellow Lane on May 9, 2019, at 7:00 p.m.

Board of School Trustee members in attendance were Michael Allen, Katie Chamness, Brad DuBois, Jessica Elston, and Scott Flood. Also in attendance were Scott Olinger, and approximately 128 guests. When President Flood provided the opportunity, no one from the audience provided input regarding the agenda items.

### PRESIDENT'S PREROGATIVE

All guests were welcomed. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Flood talked about the information presented to them at the work session regarding a housing study for the Town of Plainfield. A consultant updated the Board with the housing study information since housing developments affect the schools. The Town keeps all Plainfield residents informed of their extensive planning through public meetings and documentation.

The architects presented concept drawings of Guilford Elementary to the committee earlier this week. The plans will be shared with the public in the coming months. The plan is to open the doors to Guilford Elementary in August 2021. We have not finalized the redistricting, but that is a project in the works. Future housing developments and current neighborhoods will play a role in determining the redistricting options. Therefore, we are taking time to make good decisions. We plan to update the redistricting map about one year ahead of the school opening.

Plainfield Community Middle School was one of the handful of schools in the state to earn certification as a STEM school by the Indiana Department of Education.

Last night a committee, including Katie Chamness, selected Adam Ferguson, as this year's Plainfield Teacher of the Year. Adam is a social studies teacher at the high school.

The retiring teachers were recognized and thanked for their years of service to Plainfield Schools, the students and families.

The high school percussion group was recognized for their outstanding accomplishment at their recent competition.

The first student to receive the Retired Teacher Scholarship, in honor of our retiring teachers, was recognized as the winner of the \$500 scholarship award. Any student pursuing an education degree as their secondary education degree could apply for the scholarship.

Middle school athletes were recognized for their outstanding achievements in their competitions.

A student from each school was recognized for modeling the value of the month of April.

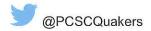

Effective July 1, 2011, section 205 of the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010 required School Food Authorities (SFAs) participating in the National School Lunch Program, to ensure that sufficient funds are provided to the food service account from paid lunches

Since our current price of paid lunches at Elementary is \$2.40 and Middle School/High School lunches are \$2.50, our prices are less than the Federal reimbursement rate, which is \$3.37 We are required to gradually increase our lunch prices until we match the Federal reimbursement rate.

To remain in compliance with the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010, I am recommending that we increase the Elementary lunch price to \$2.50 and the Middle/High School lunch price to \$2.60 for the 2019-2020 School Year.

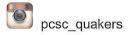

#### J-23 STUDENT DISCIPLINE

The Board of School Trustees of the Plainfield Community School Corporation adheres to the beliefs that as teachers and students are brought together so that learning may take place in classrooms, an environment which permits an orderly and efficient operation of the schools must be provided. This environment, most of all, comes through consideration and self-discipline so that individuals do not allow themselves to infringe upon the rights of others as they seek an expression for their own just and legal privileges as members of the school and society.

The entire foundation and success of public school education depends upon the basic concept of self-discipline -- a self-discipline which will allow all individuals to exist in a world of change and with the individual rights afforded them by our federal and state constitutions. Certain standards of student conduct are necessary to assure that students seeking to express their own individual rights do not at the same time infringe upon the rights of others. The responsibility for the development and maintenance of self-discipline falls to the cooperative efforts of students, parents, teachers, administrators, and the community.

The responsibility for the development and enforcement of regulations for the protection of the rights of individuals is delegated by the Board of School Trustees to responsible officials within the school corporation. The purpose of discipline controls is to help create an atmosphere that promotes the best possible learning environment for all those involved in the educational process.

An environment that provides equal opportunity for all and permits the teaching/learning process to proceed in an orderly manner is the objective of all school personnel. School staff members will make extraordinary effort, individually, collectively, and cooperatively, with appropriate available community resources, to help each student gain acceptable self-discipline standards.

Reprimand, probation, detention after school, assignment to Saturday School, referral to special personnel in the schools (counselor, assistant principal, principal), parent conference, suspension, and expulsion are courses of action available to school personnel in dealing with the pupils involved in school discipline problems.

### I-11 HOMELESS STUDENTS: ENROLLMENT RIGHTS AND SERVICES

Children who meet the Federal definition of "homeless" will be provided a free appropriate public education in the same manner as all other students of the corporation and will not be stigmatized or segregated on the basis of their status as homeless. No homeless student will be denied enrollment based on a lack of proof of residency. No Board policy, administrative guideline, or practice will be interpreted or applied in such a way as to inhibit the enrollment, attendance, or school success of homeless students.

Homeless students will be provided services comparable to other students in the corporation, including:

- 1. transportation services;
- educational services provided under Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Act or similar State and local programs;
- programs for children with disabilities;
- programs for students with limited English proficiency;
- 5. programs in vocational and technical education;
- programs for gifted and talented students;
- 7. school nutrition programs.

The superintendent will appoint a Liaison for Homeless Children who will perform the duties as assigned by the superintendent. Additionally, the liaison will coordinate and collaborate with the State Coordinator for the Education of Homeless Children and Youth as well as with community and school personnel responsible for the provision of education and related services to homeless children and youths.

To the extent practical and as required by law, the corporation will work with homeless students and their families to provide stability in school attendance and other services. Special attention will be given to ensuring the enrollment and attendance of homeless students not currently attending school. Homeless students will be provided corporation services for which they are eligible, including Head Start, Title I, special education bilingual education, vocational and technical education programs, gifted and talented programs and school nutrition programs.

Homeless students are defined as lacking a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence, including:

- 1. Sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason:
- 2. Living in motels, hotels, trailer parks or camping grounds due to the lack of alternative adequate accommodations;
- 3. Living in emergency or transitional shelters;
- 4. Are abandoned in hospitals;
- 5. Living in public or private places not designed for or ordinarily used as regular sleeping accommodations for human beings;

- 6. Living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations or similar settings; or
- 7. Are migratory children living in conditions described in the previous examples.

An unaccompanied youth is a homeless student who is not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian.

The superintendent shall designate an appropriate staff person to be the corporation's liaison for homeless students and their families.

Homeless students will continue to be enrolled in their school or origin while they remain homeless or until the end of the academic year in which they obtain permanent housing. Instead of remaining in the school of origin, parents or guardians of homeless students may request enrollment in the school in the attendance area the student is actually living. Attendance rights by living in attendance areas, other student assignment or student choice or transfer policies are available to homeless families on the same terms as families who are resident in the school corporation.

If there is an eligibility or enrollment dispute, the student shall be immediately enrolled in the school in which enrollment is sought, pending resolution of the dispute. The parent, guardian, or unaccompanied youth shall be informed of the corporation's decision and their appeal rights in writing. The corporation's liaison will carry out the dispute resolution as provided by state rule.

Once the enrollment decision is made, the school shall immediately enroll the student, pursuant to corporation policies. If the student does not have immediate access to immunization records, the student shall be admitted under a personal exception. Students and families should be encouraged to obtain current immunization records or immunizations as soon as possible, and the corporation liaison is to assist in this process. Records from the student's previous school shall be requested from the previous school pursuant to corporation policies. Emergency contact information is required at the time of enrollment consistent with corporation policies.

Homeless students are entitled to transportation to their school of origin or the school where they are to be enrolled. If the school of origin is in a different school corporation, or a homeless student is living in another school corporation but will attend his or her school of origin in this corporation, the two school corporations will coordinate to determine the responsibilities and costs of each corporation to provide the transportation services necessary for the student. If the two school corporations do not agree upon an arrangement, the responsibilities and costs for the transportation services will be shared equally by the two school corporations.

The corporation's liaison for homeless students and their families shall coordinate with local social service agencies that provide services to homeless children and youths and their families; other school corporations on issues of transportation and records transfers; and state and local housing agencies responsible for comprehensive housing affordability strategies. This coordination includes providing public notice of the education and appeal rights of homeless students in a manner understandable to the homeless students, their parents or guardians, and unaccompanied youth. The notice shall be disseminated in locations frequented by homeless students, their parents or guardians, and unaccompanied youth.

The corporation's liaison will be responsible to review and recommend amendments to corporation polices that may act as barriers to the enrollment of homeless students.
