

The BOCES recognizes the importance of providing a variety of instructional materials and resources to the students to achieve success in their programs.

The Director of each program shall be responsible for ensuring that appropriate instructional materials are being used to effectuate the classes and programs. Requests for materials shall be reviewed to ensure there ability to assist instruction of students.

As new technologies are developed they will be assessed to determine their usefulness in the appropriate programs. The District Superintendent will ensure that computer technology will be developed to assist the instructional process.

If a parent or community member objects to the use of a specific instructional material used in the BOCES program, he or she may express that concern through the procedure established in policy 6012, Objections to Curricula or Instructional Materials. The BOCES has final authority and responsibility concerning curriculum and instructional materials.
