1. Proposal for Energy Project - Ronn Gifford

Mr. Gifford presented a Preliminary Energy Saving Report from Trane based on energy consumption at our various schools. The information presented was primarily associated with solar energy. A sample site was used as a point of discussion. The members of the committee were appreciative of the work Mr. Gifford was able to do in this preliminary discussion. Many questions were asked based on the preliminary report that was presented. The committee stated a continued interest in energy savings. The facilities committee agreed to continue to discuss the information as other projects reach conclusion.

2. Bond proposal discussion

3. Recycling - discussion topic from Wendy Brotherlin

Clarification on why the move away from district/school recycling. Our provider announced they would be charging by the pound due to increased costs. Recycling was not budgeted and therefore the move away from it. (We still are doing bottles/cans and cardboard.) Individual school classroom, PTCO, etc. may look into how to continue recycling efforts in school however, will need to plan accordingly around logistics.
