PARENTS' RIGHT TO KNOW POLICY

At the beginning of each school year, a student's parents/guardians may request information regarding the professional qualifications of their student's teacher/s. Specifically, the parent has the right-to-know:

- 1 whether a teacher has met state qualifications for license and certification,
- 2 whether the teacher is teaching under an emergency or provisional certificate, and
- 3 the baccalaureate and graduate degree majors of the teacher/s

Additionally, parents may request information concerning whether the student will be provided assistance from paraprofessionals and, if so, the qualifications of the paraprofessional. Timely notification also is required if a student receives instruction from an unqualified teacher for four or more consecutive weeks.
