The ceremony will take place Saturday, May 23, at 10 a.m. in the middle school gymnasium.

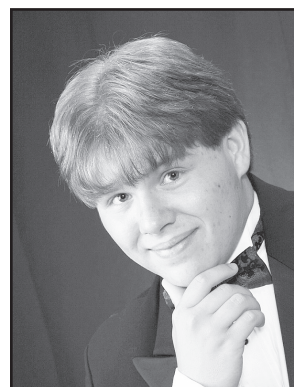

Grades 1 –5: Six Weeks, June 8 - July 23 at PECES

Summer Success in Reading and Math

Grade 6: Six Weeks, June 8 - July 23 at PECMS

Summer Success in Reading and Math will engage students in reading, writing, vocabulary and word study activities each day. Each week students will receive a very attractive magazine to use in class and to take home at the end of the week. They will also participate in a variety of activities in math in number operations, patterns and algebra, measurement and problem solving. Students will focus on math as reason-ing and thinking in small groups, with partners and independently.

“Looking back, moving forward”

Program to commemorate 50th anniversary of Prince Edward school closing

PE graduates from six decades will discuss 50 years of progress

The Prince Edward County Schools will commemorate the 50th anniversary of the 1959 closing of the county's public schools with a panel discussion program. The event will take place at 6 p.m. Friday, May 22, in the Prince Edward County High School auditorium. It is open to the public.

The six panelists are Prince Edward graduates, from the 1950s to the 21st century. Under the topic “Looking back; moving forward,” the panel will address from their own perspectives both the school division's history, when during the era of Massive Resistance the county chose to close its public schools rather than desegregate, and its progress over the past 50 years.

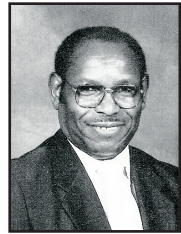
Mr. Ralph W. Baker, this year's graduation speaker and a 1985 Prince Edward graduate, will serve as moderator.

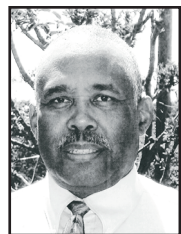
Mr. James A. Epps graduated from R. R. Moton High School in

the Class of 1957. The son of Lazarus and Helen Epps, he had returned to Prince Edward with his mother to attend school. After graduation he held many jobs and finally settled on a career as a firefighter in the Baltimore County Fire Department. He retired in 1999 after 32 years of service.

Mr. Everett R. Berryman Jr., a Prince Edward native, received most of his primary and secondary education in the county, graduating from R. R. Moton High School in 1967. 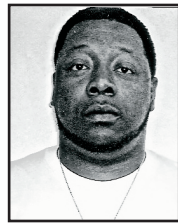
