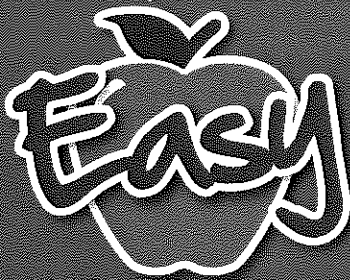

- Form 1099-C (canceled debt)

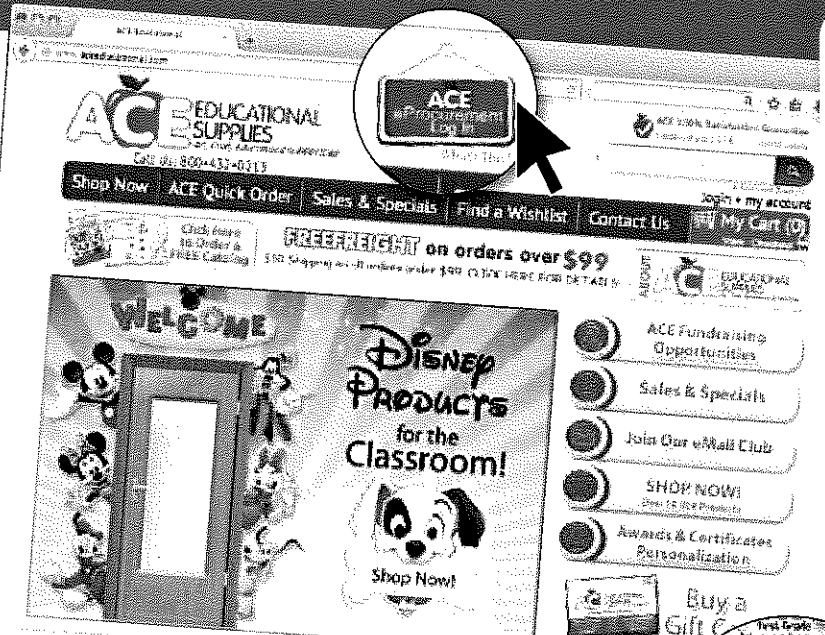

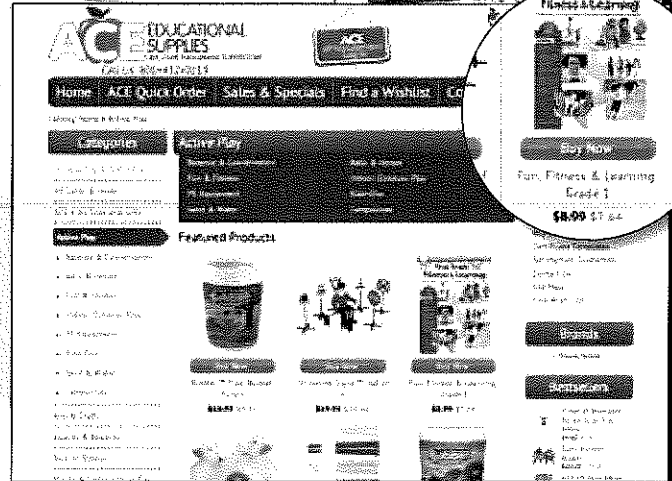
