## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE MORTON SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE MORTON EDUCATION ASSOCIATION

- **1.** Parties. This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is made and entered into by and between the Morton School District, hear-after referred to as District, and the Morton Education Association, hear-after referred to as Association.
- **2. Purpose.** The purpose of this MOU is to state agreement on a typographical error found in the collective bargaining agreement (CBA) between the Association and District.
- **Term of MOU**. This MOU is effective upon signing of this MOU and will be corrected in the CBA upon the next ratification and update, expected to be in the summer of 2019.
- **4. Corrections.** In Article IV, Part A, Number 1:

<u>Current Language</u>: When an employee will be absent from work due to illness, he/she shall give notice to the principal or the person designated by the Superintendent to receive such notice not later than 6:00 am of the first day of the illness. If the absence may be for consecutive days, the District should be notified of the probable date of return.

<u>Corrected Language</u>: When an employee will be absent from work due to illness, he/she shall—give notice to the principal or the person designated by the Superintendent to receive such notice no later than 6:00 am of the first day of the illness. If the absence may be for consecutive days, the District should be notified of the probable date of return.

5. <u>Signatures</u>. In witness whereof, the parties to this MOU through their duly authorized representatives have executed this MOU on the days and dates set out below, and certify that they have read, understood, and agreed to the terms and conditions of this MOU as set forth herein.
