

Supervised Agricultural Experiences (SAE)

SAEs are an integral part of successful agriculture education programs and ours' is no different. All students are required to establish an SAE in their first semester of enrollment. Projects are based upon student interest and accessibility with a goal of connecting real world experience and classroom instruction. Students use AET as management software. Student SAEs are eligible for awards through the Proficiency Award Program at the Section, District, State and National Levels.



Community Service has always been an important aspect of our work. "Living to Serve" is not just a part of the FFA Motto, it is character trait to be instilled in our members. Throughout the year, our members have been involved in numerous activities to benefit our local community as well as others in need. That service has been in the form of volunteer hours, donations and fundraising. Members have volunteered their time to assist at the Milton Corn Carnival running Bingo, assisting at the concession stand and gathering and disposing of trash. Our members have worked with the Pike County Historical Society to ring the bells in remembrance of Pearl Harbor. Gathering food and household supplies for tornado victims as well as raising funds through the Grinch and Mooove the Herd projects and donating backpacks and supplies to all local law enforcement are just a two more community service projects. Members raised funds to purchase books for each kindergarten students at South Elementary in order to encourage literacy and delivered them at the end of the school year as a part of the Bookends Project. Through a combination of extended contract days and the State Agriculture Education Line Item funded Three Circle Grant, the Pittsfield High School agriculture instructor is under a 12 month contract and asked to accrue 400 hours of work outside of the regular school day hours. This is done through a variety of activities. From CDE practices and competitions to conferences and SAE work as well as State Level Committee work by the instructor, 806 additional hours were accrued by one instructor.
