## **District Staff Requests for Non-Resident Admission**

Per SB2390 and PA 103-11, a school district may adopt a policy to waive tuition costs for a nonresident pupil if the pupil is a child of a district employee. For purposes of this paragraph, "child" means a district employee's child who is a biological child, adopted child, foster child, stepchild, or a child for which the employee serves as a legal guardian.

By May 1st of each school year, District Staff may notice school administration of his or her intent to enroll a child in the Pikeland School district. Exceptions to the May 1<sup>st</sup> would be for employees hired after the May 1<sup>st</sup> date.

The Superintendent may approve the request subject to the following:

- 1. The student's parent/guardian is an active employee of the District.
- 2. The student will be accepted only if there is sufficient room.
- 3. The student will attend on a year-to-year basis. Approval for any one year is not authorization for automatic attendance the following year.
- 4. The student's parent(s)/guardian(s) will be responsible for transporting the student to and from school and any extra-curricular activities.
- 5. Requests for students with an IEP will be referred to our Special Services Department for evaluation prior to approval.
