What are we going to do at SJHS?

- Strengthen PLC process focused around four central questions.
- Create common formative assessments
- Analyze ACT Aspire interim, iReady diagnostic data, and Ready Standards Mastery
- Provide intervention and enrichment during flex day
- All advisory classes will put an emphasis on reading during the week with rotations to utilize the library and enforcing common reading strategies
- Continue the work from Solution Tree CRTL vocabulary instruction in all classes
- Provide Strategic Reading classes



How will we measure progress?

Common Assessments to determine students who need intervention during

flex day.

- ACT Aspire Interim and iReady diagnostic data fall, winter, spring
- ACT Aspire Summative Assessment Spring
- Classroom Walkthrough data and instructional rounds.



Professional Learning and Timelines

- All teachers will be trained by the 5-12 literacy specialist on best practices to focus on reading.
- Training will be provided to all teachers in the use of ACT Aspire reports.
- RISE training will be provided by in-district RISE trainers as prescribed by ADE to all teachers and administrators.
- 1st Wednesday of each month will be early dismissal for professional development.
