Suggested Timeline for Standardized Testing

Junior Year:

- PSAT October
 - Once students receive their PSAT results back in December, they will have a better idea of whether or not they are going to plan to take the SAT and/or the ACT.
- SAT and/or ACT
 - Below is a list of when the SATs and ACTs are offered.
 - Students should plan to take the test of their choice twice.

*SAT II				May 6th	June 3rd

^{*}If a student is looking at highly competitive schools, he/she should plan to take the SAT II (subject) tests as well. May or June of a student's junior year is the recommended time to take SAT II tests. Students can take up to 3 subjects in 1 test administration.

Senior Year:

Repeat the ACT (September) and/or SAT (October)

Notes on Registration:

- With the exception of the April 5th SAT, students register for the SATs through the College Board (<u>www.collegeboard.com</u>) and the ACTs through ACT(<u>http://www.act.org/</u>).
- For the April 5th SAT, since the State is funding this test for all juniors, all juniors will be automatically registered for this test. More information on this will be coming from administration.
- ❖ BHS administers all SAT tests and only the April and October ACT dates. If a student would like to take the ACT during a month other than April or October, he/she will have to select a different school location.
