#### CONSTITUTION

#### Preamble

We. the members of the Barrington High School, in order to develop a further understanding and appreciation of foreign cultures, do hereby establish this constitution for the International Club of the Barrington High School.

### Article 1

#### Name

Section 1. The name of this organization will be the International Club of the Barrington High School.

### Article Z

### Purpose

- Section 1. The purpose of this organization will be:
  - To introduce students to aspects of foreign countries not covered in the school's curriculum.
  - To broaden a student's horizons and global awareness.
  - 3. To work with international students to help them adjust to American culture while helping other students learn about the foreign students own cultures.

### Article 3

### Membership

- Section 1. The International Club will be composed of any interested students attending Barrington High School.
- Section 2. The members will make a commitment to attend all meetings and to prepare themselves for all activities held during the school year.

### Article 4

### Officers

- Section 1. The officers will consist of a president, a vicepresident, a secretary-treasurer, a publicity chairperson, and a social chairperson.
- Section 2. The officers will be elected annually for a one-year term.

### Article 5

## Duties and Powers of the Officers

### Section 1. The president will:

- work with the sponsor, and possibly with the other officers, to plan meetings and activities.
- 2. oversee the work of the other officers.
- 3. preside at meetings and activities.
- 4. take notices of upcoming events to the main office for announcement purposes.

## Section 2. The vice-president will:

- perform any of the president's duties when she/he is unable to do so.
- keep in close contact with the president to be of aid as needed.

### Section 3. The secretary-treasurer will:

- keep a list of members.
- write correspondence, such as thank-you notes and invitations.
- 3. keep track of the amount in the club treasury.
- 4. suggest ways to earn money for the treasury.

## Section 4. The publicity chairperson will:

 arrange for posters or other means to publicize upcoming events.

## Section 5. The social chairperson will:

- arrange for someone to bring refreshments to meetings.
- 2. arrange for food lists for dinner meetings.
- keep on hand stock of paper goods for refreshments, dinners.
- 4. arrange for persons to clean up after meetings or other events.

#### Article 6

### Duties of the Sponsor

## Section 1. 1. Will attend all meetings.

- 2. Will help students in the preparation for dinners, guest speakers and other activities held throughout the school year.
- 3. Will arrange with the administration for rooms for meetings and activities.
- 4. Will meet with officers for planning purposes.
- 5. Will cooperate with AFS Barrington chapter and the Foreign Language Department of Barrington High School as requested.

## Article 7

# Date and Place of Meeting

- Section 1. The International Club will meet:
  - 1. Once a month in a predetermined place.
  - Other activities may be held as planned in appropriate locations.

# Date Effective

Section 1. The constitution will be effective immediately after ratification by the School Committee.
