**CONSTITUTION  
Of the  
CAESAR REGIT COLLEGIUM (THE LATIN CLUB)**

**PREAMBLE**

We, the members of Barrington High School, in order to assist in the education of the Latin language, gain cultural knowledge about the Roman people, and celebrate a love for Latin hereby establish this constitution for the Caesar Regit Collegium (The Latin Club).

**ARTICLE I: PURPOSE**

**Section 1:** The activities that may occur at club meetings are:

- Sharing and planning future events.
- Sampling of fine Roman cuisine.
- Workshops for particularly challenging units that may have come up in Latin class as well as reviewing (biannually) for exams.
- Social events (i.e. toga parties, observance of Roman holidays, Roman movie nights, etc.) to further admiration for Roman society and culture.
- The club may arrange, through the Director of Student Activities, social events where and when appropriate for the purpose of increasing awareness of Roman culture.

**ARTICLE II: RULES OF CONDUCT**

**Section 1:** All members must adhere to the following guidelines:

- Students must show a love for Roman society and a desire to learn more about its fascinating culture.
- Students must respect other club members and themselves as well as excessive enthusiasm for the Latin language that may be present at meetings.
- Students must follow instruction of the advisors, and meetings must not be held without an advisor present.
- Students must not initiate meetings, activities or programs, or distribute pamphlets or other literature without the consent of the advisors
- Students must show respect for school property

**ARTICLE III: MEMBERSHIP**

**Section 1:** Membership in Caesar Regit is open to any student enrolled at Barrington High School, whether or not that student is enrolled in Latin class. Members must display a willingness to immerse themselves in the exploration of Roman mores as well as a salubrious interest in the club's ambitions.

**ARTICLE IV: DUTIES OF THE ADVISOR**

**Section 1:** Shall attend all meetings, approve all programs, supervise all activities, and share his or her adoration and wisdom of ancient societies with members of Caesar Regit Collegium.

**ARTICLE V: MEETINGS**

**Section 1:** The club will meet in the evening as necessary for exciting Latin related activities and celebrations.
