CONSTITUTION OF THE CHINESE CLUB

PREAMBLE

We, the member of Barrington High School, with the intention of facilitating greater education in Chinese culture and commencing our use of the spoken and written Chinese language, hereby establish this constitution for the Chinese Club.

ARTICLE I: PURPOSE

Section 1: The activities and endeavors that may arise at club meetings are:

- The study of Chinese culture through:
 - Food
 - Music
 - Movies
 - Holidays/traditions
 - Stories
- The study of the Mandarin Chinese language (reading, speaking, and writing) through:
 - Pinyin
 - Simplified characters

ARTICLE II: RULES OF CONDUCT

Section 1: All members of the club must adhere to the following regulations:

- Members must attend a majority of the club's meetings.
- Members must follow the instructions and assignments of officers and the club advisor.
- Members must demonstrate respect for fellow members, school property, and the Chinese culture itself.

ARTICLE III: MEMBERSHIP

Section 1: Membership in the club is open to all students enrolled at Barrington High School.

ARTICLE IV: DUTIES OF THE ADVISOR

Section 1: The duties of the club advisor will be to approve, attend and supervise all club meetings and all in-school and out of school activities.

ARTICLE V: MEETINGS

Section 1: The club will generally meet on a weekly basis or as deemed necessary by the club members.
