

CONSTITUTION
Of the
BARRINGTON HIGH SCHOOL ROBOTICS CLUB

Preamble

We, the members of the Barrington High School, in order increase school spirit and enhance student development, do hereby establish the constitution of the **Barrington High School Robotics Club**.

ARTICLE I
NAME

Section 1 The name of this organization shall be the **Barrington High School Robotics Club**.

ARTICLE II
PURPOSE

Section 1 The purpose of this organization shall be to

- a. further the study of science outside the classroom
- b. provide an environment where students can meet with students sharing an interest in robotics
- c. provide a project-driven environment where students apply robotics to real-world problems
- d. provide students hands-on experience in construction and experimentation with robots
- e. participate in competitions deemed suitable and relevant to the projects being undertaken.

ARTICLE III
MEMBERSHIP

Section 1 The **Barrington High School Robotics Club** will be composed of any interested students attending Barrington High School.

Section 2 The members shall make a commitment to attend as many meetings as possible.

Section 3 Members must show a clear and continuing interest in learning about robotics, and be willing to invest time as needed in research and/or construction.

ARTICLE IV
DUTIES OF THE ADVISOR

- Section 1** The advisor will:
attend all meetings
- Section 2** provide guidance in selecting, planning, and executing robotics projects
- Section 3** mentor students directly, and as necessary, bring in other mentors.

ARTICLE IV
DATE AND PLACE OF MEETINGS

- Section 1** Meetings with all members will be held monthly, either after school at the Barrington High School, or some other location deemed appropriate or necessary.
- Section 2** Smaller, individual project-centric team meetings will be held on ad-hoc, as needs basis.

ARTICLE VI
DATE EFFECTIVE

- Section 1** This constitution shall be effective immediately after ratification by the School Committee.
