

**C O N S T I T U T I O N**  
**of the**  
**NEW ENGLAND MATH CLUB**

**PREAMBLE**

We, the members of the Barrington High School, in order to increase school spirit and enhance student development, do hereby establish this constitution for the **New England Math Club of Barrington High School**.

**ARTICLE I**  
**NAME AND PURPOSE**

Section 1                   The name of this organization shall be the **New England Math Club of the Barrington High School**.

Section 2                   The purposes of this organization shall be:

- 1)   to further the study of mathematics outside the classroom;
- 2)   to provide students with the opportunity to compete with each other at the school level;
- 3)   to provide students with an opportunity to be recognized for their accomplishments during the competitions within their own class; and
- 4)   to participate in the New England Mathematics League.

**ARTICLE II**  
**MEMBERSHIP**

Section 1                   The **New England Math Club of Barrington High School** shall be composed of any interested students attending Barrington High School.

Section 2                   The members shall make a commitment to attend as many practices as possible and to participate in the six contests held throughout the year.

**ARTICLE III**  
**DUTIES OF THE SPONSOR**

Section 1                   Shall attend all meetings.

Section 2                   Shall conduct problem solving sessions.

Section 3                   Shall correct all tests and mail in results to the League office.

Section 4                   Shall conduct follow-up discussions after tests.

**ARTICLE IV  
DATE/PLACE OF MEETING**

Section 1 Contest dates are set annually by the League office.

Section 2 Practice/discussion dates are set around the contest dates.

Section 3 All sessions will be conducted immediately after school and will be held in the high school.

**ARTICLE V  
DATE EFFECTIVE**

Section 1 The Constitution shall be effective immediately after ratification by the school committee.
