

School Committee Elections

The School Committee shall be elected by the electors of the Town of Barrington at the regular biennial election held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November in even numbered years and shall serve for a term of four years.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, any vacancy in the School Committee shall be filled for the unexpired term by a vote of the electors of the Town. Such vacancy shall be filled at the next regular or special election to be held in the Town or the Council may call a special election for the purpose of filling the vacancy. If a vacancy in the School Committee shall occur more than nine (9) months prior to the time for the holding of an election, the Council shall, within thirty (30) days after the vacancy occurs, call a special election for the purpose of filling such vacancy.
