

Transportation

All pupils attending grades K-5 residing in the Town of Barrington who live more than three-quarters of a mile from the school attended and all pupils attending grades 6-12 residing in the Town of Barrington who live more than two miles from the school attended are entitled to transportation.

Distances will be determined according to the shortest route by traveled road and/or paved public sidewalk.

Bus routes will be established so that an authorized bus stop is available for eligible students at a walking distance from their home of no more than the distances contained in paragraph one. Exceptions to the foregoing shall be determined in the light of all factors, including circumstances of safety and the physical condition, or other special needs of the child.

The School Committee shall provide transportation in accordance with the law to Barrington residents attending private and parochial schools.
