STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

The purpose of school transportation is to transport students to and from school in an efficient, safe and economical manner. Additional purposes include the transportation for academic field trips in direct support of curriculum and the transportation for co-curricular activities sponsored by the District.

District owned vehicles will be provided by the Board for the transport of students in transportation areas to and from school. It may be impractical to transport certain special education students by regular or special buses, they may be transported by other conveyance. The transportation supervisor, working in conjunction with school principals and under the supervision of the business manager, will be responsible for the day to day operation of the school transportation system; scheduling and routing of all buses, bus stops, safety and compliance with state and federal regulations.
