What is a GPA?

- GPA stands for Grade Point Average
- Your grade point average is affected by every course you take.
- Honors and AP Courses give you more points towards your weighted GPA, you can have a weighted GPA above a 4.0. We rank students based on a weighted GPA.
- The highest unweighted GPA you can have is a 4.0, honors and AP do not impact this GPA.

Graduation Requirements for the c/o 2026

- 4 English Credits
- 4 Math credits
- 3 Science credits (Earth/Environmental Science, Biology and a physical science)
- 4 History (World, American History, Economics and Personal Finance, Civic Literacy)
- 1 Health/PE Credit
- 2 of the following: CTE, Arts or World Language* courses. (**If you are planning on attending a four year university right after high school, World Language is required for admission. It is not a graduation requirement.*)
- 10 electives (4 must be in a concentration area)
- Take the four required EOC's (English II, NC Math I, NC Math III Biology)

What is a concentration area?

- A concentration is 2 courses in a particular area. These courses are in addition to those required for graduation.
- The purpose of a concentration is to provide additional exposure in an area of interest you may have.
- This may help you:
 - decide what you want to do after high school
 - decide you do **not** want to do after high school
 - expose you to an interest or talent you didn't realize you had!
- Humanities – combination of English, Social Studies, AVID
- STEM – Science, Technology, Engineering, Math
- AP or University level courses.
- World Languages
- ROTC
- The Arts
- Health and Physical education- Four upper level PE courses
- Career and Technical Education- must complete 4 in a career cluster.
