Hold a valid West Virginia teaching certificate as set forth by the West Virginia State Board of Education in Minimum Standards for Licensure of West Virginia School Personnel or hold an Adult License endorsed for teaching Adult Basic Education.

Immediate Supervisor: Director of High Schools and Career-Technical Education

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Implement his/her program of study.
- 2. Foster a climate conducive to learning.
- 3. Utilize instructional management system that increases student learning and maximizes time on tasks.
- 4. Monitor student progress toward learning outcomes.
- 5. Maintain and upgrade his/her professional skills.
- 6. Promote and maintain positive student-teacher relationships.
- Maintain professional work habits.
- Complete six hours pre-service training as required by the West Virginia Department of Education.
- 9. Complete six hours in-service training annually as required by the West Virginia Department of Education.
