## Qualifications:

- 1. Education: Hold a valid West Virginia teaching certificate as set forth by the West Virginia State Board of Education in Minimum Standards for Licensure of West Virginia School Personnel.
- 2. Ability to work amiably with people of all educational and socioeconomic backgrounds.
- 3. Ability to plan, organize, and teach adult education classes.
- 4. Ability to adapt work schedule to the needs of students.
- 5. Ability to select, administer, and evaluate ability and interest evaluation instruments.

## Immediate Supervisor: Director of Secondary Education

## **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- 1. Implement his/her program of study.
- 2. Foster a climate conducive to learning.
- 3. Utilize an instructional management system that increases student learning and maximizes time on tasks.
- 4. Monitor student progress toward learning outcomes.
- 5. Maintain and upgrade his/her professional skills.
- 6. Promote and maintain positive student-teacher relationships.
- 7. Maintain professional work habits.
- 8. Establish good public and employee relations.
- 9. Coordinate and teach adult basic and other adult education classes, including GED option classes, as assigned by the director of secondary education.
- 10. Confer with parents and teachers regarding the development needs of individual vocational students.
- 11. Provide leadership in planning and implementing career development experiences.
- 12. Coordinate, based on student assessments/needs, the referral of vocational students for school and community services.
- 13. Complete required reports within established time lines.
- 14. Conduct follow-up studies as requested.
- 15. Collect and maintain student data.
- 16. Complete eight (8) hours pre-service training as required by the West Virginia Department of Education.
- 17. Complete six (6) hours in-service training annually as required by the West Virginia Department of Education.
- 18. Job shadow experienced ABE teachers as directed by supervisor.
- 19. Use available technology in the implementation of the program.
- 20. Perform other job-related duties as assigned by the director of secondary schools.
