## Qualifications:

- 5. Ability to meet the physical needs of students such as lifting and positioning.

- 1. Current employee of the Jackson County Board of Education.
- 2. Previous experience in working with school age children within a school system.
- 3. Related college level course work in human development and education.
- 4. Excellent physical condition in order to meet specialized needs of students within the school system.

## **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- 1. Assists in the supervision of special education students as designated by the bus operator.
- 2. Assists in meeting the physical needs of students such as lifting, positioning, etc.
- 3. Assists bus operators in monitoring students such as lifting, positioning, etc.
- 4. Assists in meeting medical emergencies of special education students.
- 5. Attends inservice training specific to assignment.
- 6. Provides basic record keeping information to the bus operator.
- 7. Maintains positive work habits within the school environment.
- 8. Establishes and maintains cooperative relationships with bus operator and parents.
- 9. Demonstrates courtesy and cooperation in dealing with persons both internal and external to the school site.
- 10. Performs duties efficiently and productively.
- 11. Performs other job related tasks as assigned by the director or special services.
