- Ability to communicate effectively with students, school personnel, and parents.

## **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- 1. Monitor and observe special education programs and services in special and regular education settings on a scheduled basis.
- Provide technical assistance to principals, LSICs, IEP teams, and teachers regarding effective instruction and best practice, special education service delivery options, and staffing considerations.
