DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Coordinate Grades 6-12 implementation of all aspects of Response to Intervention (RTI)
2. Visit middle and high schools and observe in classrooms for the purpose of monitoring tiered instruction.
3. Monitor and evaluate the implementation of benchmark assessments in middle and high schools.
4. Monitor and assist student intervention teams in middle and high schools.
5. Assist with the development and implementation of tiered instructional programs in the four middle and high schools.
6. Plan and implement professional development designed to meet defined needs of RTI.
7. Provide orientation and systematic follow-up assistance to personnel implementing RTI.
8. Consult with teachers and parents to assist in meeting students' academic needs.
9. Provide public relations activities to communicate program goals and accomplishments to students, staff, parents, and community members.
10. Maintain accurate, complete, and punctual records as required by law, county policy, program or administrative directives.
11. Maintain and improve professional skills through participation in relevant staff development programs.
12. Perform other job related duties as assigned by the Director of Federal Programs.
