  are representing their school at athletic events, practice sessions, parades, pep
  rallies, etc.
- 3. Assure that school rules and policies are enforced as they relate to the auxiliary corp.
- Establish and maintain record keeping systems as required.
- Assist the band director in the selection of auxiliary members.
- 6. Manage the selection, use, distribution, care, and collection of uniforms.
- Foster a climate conducive to learning.
- Maintain and upgrade his/her skills in the areas of responsibility.
- Promote good public relations for the auxiliary members, band program, school, community, and school system.
