Qualifications:

- 1. Holds West Virginia Certification in the area of Music Grades 6-12.
- 2. Exhibits knowledge in the area of choral music, as well as the duties and responsibilities of a choral director and the ability to perform the duties and responsibilities as demonstrated in the personal interview.
- 3. Specialized training in the area of choral music and programs.
- 4. Satisfactory evaluations.
- 5. Ability to communicate and work effectively and cooperatively with students, school personnel, and parents.

Immediate Supervisor: School Principal

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Develop, implement, and manage the extracurricular choral program.
- 2. Conduct tryouts and select students to participate in the extracurricular program.
- 3. Establish, communicate, and implement after school schedules for practice and performances.
- 4. Provide a minimum of two choral programs for parents and public (middle school only). Provide a minimum of three choral programs for parents and public in addition to performing for other school/community events as approved by the school principal (high school only).
- 5. Supervise members of the choral program whenever they are practicing or performing for the school or the public.
- 6. Work to improve students' choral music skills.
- 7. Foster a climate conducive to learning.
- 8. Promote good public relations for the choral music program, school, community, and school system.
- 9. Promote and maintain positive student/teacher/parent relationships.
- 10. Perform other job related duties as assigned by the principal.
