MAJORETTE SPONSOR

Job Description

Qualification:

- 1. Certified as a teacher by the West Virginia State Board of Education.
- 2. Exhibits knowledge in the area of majorette performance, as well as the duties and responsibilities of a majorette sponsor and the ability to perform the duties and responsibilities as demonstrated in the personal interview.
- 3. Good evaluations and/or recommendations from professional associates, employers and/or supervisors.
- 4. Ability to communicate effectively with students, school personnel, and parents.
- 5. Ability to work cooperatively with others.

Immediate Supervisor: Band Director and School Principal

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Instruct majorettes in routines which will be performed at athletic events, parades, etc., within the guidelines provided.
- Assist the band director in the supervision of majorettes whenever they are representing their school at athletic events, practice sessions, parades, pep rallies, etc.
- 3. Assure that school rules and policies are enforced as they relate to the majorette corp.
- 4. Establish and maintain record keeping systems as required.
- 5. Assist the band director in the selection of majorettes.
- Manage the selection, use, distribution, care, and collection of uniforms.
- 7. Foster a climate conducive to learning.
- 8. Maintain and upgrade his/her skills in the areas of responsibility.
- 9. Promote good public relations for the majorette, band program, school, community, and school system.
- 10. Perform other job-related duties as assigned by the band director or principal.
