- 3. Good evaluations and/or recommendations from professional associates, employers, and/or supervisors.
- 4. Exhibits knowledge of the duties and responsibilities of the homebound teacher and the ability to perform the duties and responsibilities as demonstrated in the personal interview.
- 5. Ability to communicate effectively with students, school personnel, and parents.
- 6. Educational philosophy compatible with the Jackson County Board of Education philosophy.
- 7. Ability to work cooperatively with others.

Immediate Supervisor: Director of Special Education

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Implement the assigned programs of study to homebound students.
- 2. Works as a liaison between the regular classroom teacher(s) and homebound student(s).
- 3. Monitor student progress towards achieving instructional objectives.
- 4. Maintain and upgrade professional skills.
- 5. Promote and maintain positive pupil-teacher-parent relationships.
- 6. Maintain professional work habits.
- 7. Perform other job related duties as assigned by the director of special education.
