



Special Education Continuum of Services

Renaissance Academy provides a continuum of services to meet the individual needs of children with IEP's in the least restrictive environment. Services are determined by the Special Education staff at Renaissance Academy working jointly with the Committee on Special Education of the student's district of residence. Instructional and support staff work closely with the Coordinator of Special Services to review each IEP, provide specific academic support, program accommodations and management needs.

Renaissance Academy offers the following programs for students:

- Resource Room
- Consultant Teacher services (Direct or Indirect)
- Integrated Co-Taught classrooms
- 15:1:1 Classroom (for students with intensive academic needs)

Parents are informed of student progress through Quarterly IEP Progress Monitoring reports and Renaissance Academy report cards sent home 3 times per year, as well as parent conferences held at least once per year.
