At Renaissance Academy, we are committed to involving families in the learning process as much as possible! Each of our families is unique – with its own priorities, needs, talents, and time constraints -- for that reason we provide as many different kinds of opportunities for parental involvement as possible. Parents are surveyed in the beginning of the year to determine in what capacities they would like to serve. Parents who wish to volunteer must attend a volunteer orientation meeting prior to being able to volunteer on campus.

After the parents have been through the orientation, the Family Services Coordinator works with the parents and the teachers to set up volunteer opportunities. Volunteers are required to sign in at the main office and wear a volunteer badge while on campus.
