The Board approved Cooperative checks totaling \$3,474.90, Lunch checks totaling \$6,309.22, Escrow checks totaling \$246,192.94 and Activity checks totaling \$14,312.90.

The Elementary Principal reported Roland Johnson has been hired as the elementary custodian. Elementary remodeling is progressing well, asbestos floors have been removed, ceiling grids are in and casework will be here on June 24th. Summer School has been well attended and will finishing up on June 28th. Due to a resignation the lunch room is once again looking for help.

The Superintendent reported that State Aid is up slightly. Remodeling to both buildings is progressing well. Steel studs are installed and sheet rock is beginning. Epoxy flooring will begin on June 24th. The elementary fence project is waiting on the rolling gate. ADA sidewalks will be installed between the elementary and high school building this summer. One air conditioning unit is down in the gym and is being repaired. Due to legislative updates there will be policy updates to the board policy book. Gayle Mach has turned in her resignation as a cook at the lunch room.

There were no committee reports.

The Board discussed Phase 3 remodeling and wiring at the High School building. Lunch prices will be raised slightly to meet State lunch requirements. Mrs. Nipp had received milk bids from Dean Foods and Highland Dairy. She stated she didn't care which provider that we would go with for the 2019-2020 school year. The student dress code was discussed and new wording will be added that holes in jeans, leggings, jeggings and tights will be allowed as long as they are worn appropriately and at the Superintendent discretion as to lengths, location of the holes etc. Details will be in the Student Handbook. Annual lunch and bus reports were made available to the board members. The school may be looking into purchasing a car to help with vehicle shortages. There are times that all vans and the suburban are in use creating a shortage for staff members.

Motion by Mackeprang, seconded by Koertje, to approve the proposed changes in student and staff lunch prices for the 2019-2020 school year as presented by Mr. Alexander. K-12 Breakfast will be \$1.65, Adult breakfast is \$2.20. K-6 Lunch will be \$2.70, 7-12 \$2.85, Adults \$3.75, extra main item \$1.10, and other items .90. Daycare Breakfast \$1.10, Lunch \$2.10, Snacks .50 and extra milk will remain at .40.
