- Canvas is a Learning Management System
- Allows students and teachers to manage their coursework electronically
- Web-based
 - 24 hours a day/7 days a week
 - from Internet connected computers or mobile devices


Accessing Canvas


Canvas on the Portal



Dashboard


Course Cards:

- You can change your dashboard view





Account Settings: Registering Google Drive in Canvas



- 1. Click on account, then settings
- 2. Register Google Drive
 - a. Scroll down to web services
 - b. Under Other Services, click Google Drive
 - c. Click the "Authorize Google Drive Access" button in the box that pops onto your screen
 - d. Select *your AISD* account
 - e. Click the blue "Allow" box
 - f. Google Drive is now a registered Web Service in Canvas







Setting Up Notifications

Click on Account, then Notifications





Your district provided email is setup to receive notifications.

Settings can be set for the whole account, or course by course.

You can determine how often.

AISD recommends the following settings:

- Due date notify weekly
- Announcements notify immediately
- Grading notify immediately
- Invitations notify immediately
- Submission Comment notify immediately



Push notification options:


