Number of Students Who Received Dyslexia Intervention

During the 2018-2019 school year, 24 students attending the Smackover-Norphlet School District received dyslexia intervention services from a trained dyslexia interventionist.

Total Number of Students Identified as Exhibiting the Characteristics of Dyslexia

During the 2018-2019 school year, 26 students attending the Smackover-Norphlet School District were identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.

At the end of May, 2019, 4 additional students were identified as having the characteristics of dyslexia. These students will begin receiving dyslexia intervention services at the beginning of the 2019-2020 school year from a trained dyslexia interventionist.
