



This crucial initiative serves to offset the operational costs of the high school, as tuition and fees only cover about 60% of the expenses needed to provide the educational services offered at LCC.

Auction - Our annual auction is our biggest in-person fundraiser of the year. Support the Auction by sponsoring the event, offering an item or experience, attending the event, or bidding on items virtually!

Over the last year, donations have gone towards the purchase of new team uniforms for girls basketball, softball, football, volleyball, and cheerleading. In addition, Athletics purchased new cameras that will benefit our teams on the court.



# LIMA CENTRAL CATHOLIC EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION



**General Asset Fund** - A gift to the Lima Central Catholic Educational Foundation helps keep tuition costs down and provide tuition assistance for students who might otherwise be unable to attend LCC. The Educational Foundation is funded through donations and memorial gifts or bequests.

**Arts Endowment -** Involvement in the arts is shown to support the social and emotional learning of students. This endowment was created to establish, develop and maintain a performing and visual arts program for the students of LCC, recognizing the important role of arts education.

Teacher Endowment - Student achievement is linked to the quality of the teachers in the classroom. Market trends indicate a growing shortage of individuals pursuing the field of education nationwide. The LCCEF's Teacher Endowment Fund serves to provide ongoing resources to properly compensate and retain the dedicated faculty at LCC, and attract the best talent when we have openings. It serves to close the salary and benefit gap that currently exists between our faculty and their public school counterparts.


# FINANCE

Operational sustainability for the near and long term was the focus of the successful campaign of the LCC Educational Foundation. It has also become one of the pillars of our new strategic plan. Enrollment at LCC is growing for the first time in many years and trending upward for the next several years. Out of pocket tuition costs are down for all students, those on state scholarships and those who are not. 




### **Girls Varsity Tennis**



# **INNERVIEW**

LCC students had the opportunity this year to help build up the Kingdom of God and build a better world through the use of our new service tracking platform, InnerView. InnerView helps our students to track their service activities and to see how helping locally can make a global impact. Each activity submitted by a student to Innerview is tagged with one of the 17 United Nations (UN) Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) for a better world by 2030. This allows students to track their personal impact and their collective impact for each goal.

At the launch of the SDGs, Pope Francis endorsed the goals calling them "an important sign of hope." With their focus on ending poverty, fighting inequality, and stopping climate change, the UN goals share many values with Catholic social teaching, including the principles of human dignity, solidarity, the common good, caring for our common home, and preferential option for the poor. In his address to the Fourth World Meeting of Popular Movements (October 16, 2021), Pope Francis referred to how both Catholic Social Teaching and the SDGs call everyone to share and be involved in the common quest to build a better world. By reflecting on each activity as an act of service and an action to support the SDGs, InnerView helps LCC students see the connections between their local actions of service, the Catholic faith, and the issues of our world today.

During the 2021-2022 school year, LCC students logged a **total of 4,455 hours**. The Lima Central Catholic Educational Foundation wrapped-up a successful Capital Campaign with a celebration event on June 4th at LCC. We started the Campaign in January of 2019 with a goal of \$4M - \$6M. To date we have received \$6,020,206.43 in pledges. We exceeded our goal and are very pleased.

Due to the successes of this Campaign, the LCCEF will be able to award over 90% of LCC students a total of \$221,683 in need-based tuition assistance, grants, and meritbased scholarships for the 2022-23 school year. The amount of assistance will continue to rise as pledges are paid, promising the attainability of a Catholic Education for all families for years to come.

The Capital Campaign also resulted in \$500,000 pledged for the establishment of a Teacher Endowment Fund to help retain our extremely dedicated and qualified staff and offer salaries that are much closer to what they might earn at area public schools. This commitment by the LCCEF is extraordinary, especially as we seek to fill positions during a nationwide teacher shortage.

As we met with donors during the Capital Campaign, many expressed a passion for the arts and a desire to enhance our arts programming. An Arts Endowment Fund was created and pledges totaling approximately \$200,000 have already been dedicated to achieve this goal.

We are thrilled to be celebrating an end to a successful campaign. We have exceeded our goal of \$6 million, thanks to YOU!


In 2019, the LCCEF embarked on a pivotal \$6 million campaign to increase the assets of the Foundation which help keep tuition costs down and provide much needed tuition assistance for students, provide near-term operational support for the High School, and invest in our three elementary schools. Through these efforts new initiatives arose, including the establishment of 5 new named scholarships for Lima Central Catholic students, the forming of an Endowment to grow the Arts at LCC, and more.

















### To date, each of the elementary schools have received over \$70,000.

- **St. Charles** used these funds for a variety of new things: document cameras, Clevertouch Boards for religious classrooms and new bibles for grades K-5.
- St. Rose used funds for the Friendzy program which is a Catholic based social/emotional learning program. They also purchased supplies such as fidgets and weighted vests for students to use in the classroom, as well as religious items to teach the faith, including books, Rosary cards, Mass kits and Jesus and Mary dolls for prayer time.
- **St. Gerard** used the Capital Campaign funds to help fund the building of an 8 classroom addition to the school building for grades PK-4.

When the openings for the Space Network White Sands Ground Terminal were announced, I applied and was hired by the main contractor, Spacecom. That began a 35 year stint at the White Sands

Ground Terminal (WSGT), starting out as a Senior Technician and ending up as a Principal Design Engineer. While it was all happening, it seemed a chaotic jumble of unrelated events, but looking back, it just seems like a logical and natural progression.

### Most Memorable



The largest project, and one that saved the Space Network from extended down times and data losses, was the design, construction, and installation of the Replacement Data Bus at White Sands Ground Terminal.

It replaced a failing site control system that had never been very reliable, but the sites performance shot through the roof after the switchover to the new hardware. There were definitely other important players in the project design team, including the project manager, the software leads, and the implementation team. Still, it was a real hoot to walk out on the equipment floor and see the indicator lights on my hardware merrily flashing like a marquees they provided a visual indication of the sites activity. I have since designed critical fixes and built many new or replacement devices for the Space Network, but the Data Bus Replacement was the biggest and most memorable. The whole of the Space Network was being controlled by my hardware. What a glorious chance to "spread your wings and fly"!

### **→** Lasting Legacy



Some of my latest designs and installations that occurred in the 21st century are still in operation and supporting a wide aspect of our nation's space endeavors. The data for all of those beautiful Hubble

Telescope pictures passed through a little bit of me on it's way to earth. All of the International Space Station data is supported by Local Interface systems that were installed by my Engineering Changes. Launches and range safety now have extensive communication coverage from the TDRS satellites due to a Ground Network Modulator addition that is approximately 50% my design. In the grand scheme of our nation's space efforts, there are many people working "behind stage" that you never know about. They come from towns, cities, farms, etc. all across our nation. To my home town of Lima, Ohio, I extend a hearty "thank you" for the excellent education received in your parochial school system.



# **JAMES MCBARRON, ST. ROSE '56**

James McBarron, St. Rose 1956, was an aerospace technologist who worked on spacesuits for every NASA program, from Mercury to the International Space Station. During high school and college, McBarron worked a series of odd jobs car washer, Christmas tree lot salesman, movie theater usher, and bartender. When he was hired as a test subject (for spacesuits) for the Wright-Patterson Air Force Base Aeromedical Laboratory in 1958, the work was a lot more exotic and much more grueling. To simulate the extreme conditions of space travel, McBarron was ordered to do tests like sitting in a hot box that could reach temperatures of 200 degrees or dip into an ice water tank that averaged minus-20 degrees. McBarron did all this for \$1.85 per hour, \$3 per hour for hazardous tests, but he had found his career path. NASA offered him a job as an aerospace technologist in 1961, changing his life trajectory.

McBarron was there during the Apollo 13 crisis that inspired a book and movie. McBarron referenced his experience depicted in the movie Apollo 13 when a man in charge dumps items on a table and challenges everyone to find a solution to build a carbon dioxide filter that would keep the Apollo 13 crew alive as they traveled back to Earth. McBarron was there, in the real-life crisis. "I was one of those guys who had to solve the problem," he said.


McBarron worked for NASA from 1961 until his retirement in 1999. During his time with NASA, he supported the Manned Spacecraft Center at the Johnson Space Center in Houston, Texas and worked with spacesuits for all NASA flight programs including Mercury, Gemini, Apollo, Apollo-Soyuz Test Project, Skylab, Shuttle, and the International Space Station. In 1999, he took a position with ILC Dover, Inc. as Spacesuit Systems Manager where he reviewed advanced spacesuit technology requirements and design concepts for future manned space flight programs. In 2002, he joined the "Gray Beards" and provided knowledge and insight learned from past programs to support development of advanced spacesuit technology and inflatable products for current and future manned-space missions including the Artemis Project.

McBarron passed away in November of 2020 a the age of 82.

I recall being enthralled by space at an early age. My grandmother gifted me books about space, and I would stare in awe at the enclosed images. However, it was not until recently when I realized that the beauty of our universe could be captured from my own backyard with modest equipment. Once I learned that I do not need the equivalent of a Hubble Space Telescope, I began researching and slowly acquiring more capable tools.

Human eyes are not made for viewing many of the objects we see in space, we use cameras to capture images in order to see the details that we would otherwise miss. Most objects appear as faint, fuzzy, gray blobs when viewed through an optical telescope. However, the objects can come to life, with the help of image processing, after capturing many long exposures. Because space is dark, and because night time is dark, long exposures are needed to collect as much light as possible from the distant and faint objects that we see with our eyes. Typically, each image I take is five minutes long, and I can take upward of 500 exposures, but it depends on the target and sky quality. After I have captured all of the images that I want of a specific target, the files are inspected and processed with software to bring out the colors and details. This is the same process that goes into the images from the Hubble Space Telescope.



M42 (The Orion Nebula) is a reflection nebula that lies 1,300 lightvears from Earth, and it is visible to the naked eve when viewed away from light-polluted skies.

Astrophotography is a rewarding hobby. With the ever-growing plague of light pollution, there are places in which adults have never seen anything in the night skies other than a handful of the brightest stars. There are ways to minimize your impact on the growing problem of light pollution. To learn how you can contribute to better sky conditions, not only for hobbyists, but also for scientists, you can learn more by visiting the International Dark-Sky Association's website. There, you can learn about responsible lighting and other ways to help us preserve our night skies.
