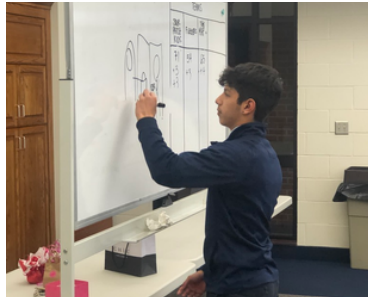
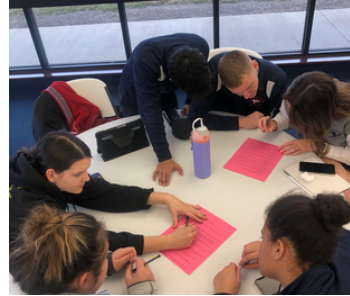
Fat Tuesday

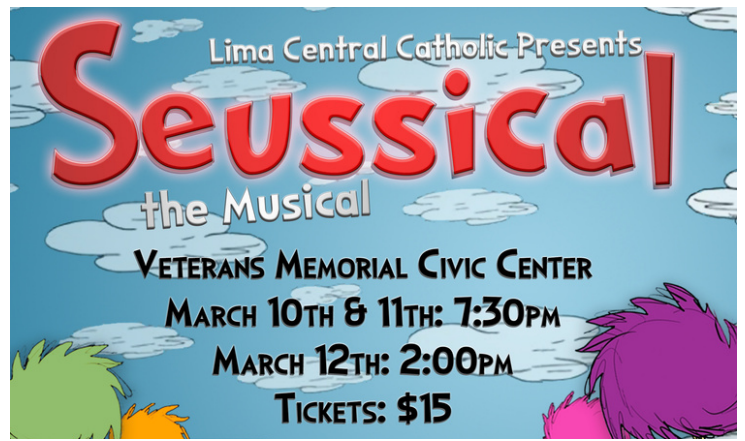
International Club

Students from Ms. Luersman's Art Classes Celebrated Black History Month by creating drawings inspired by African American artists and influential people.



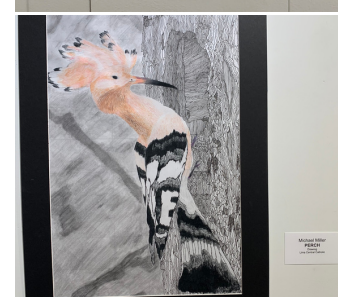
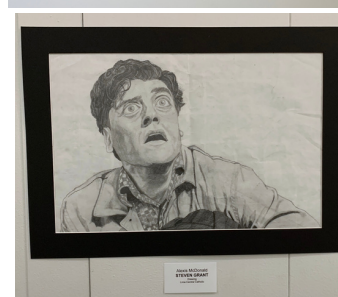
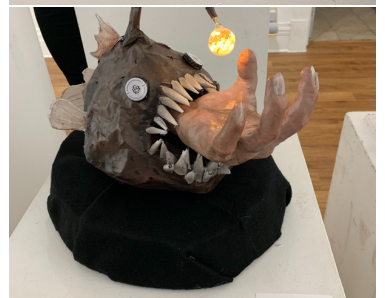
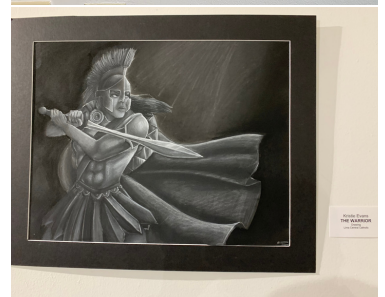
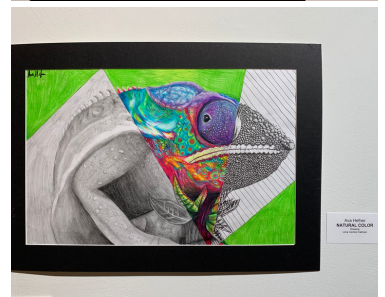
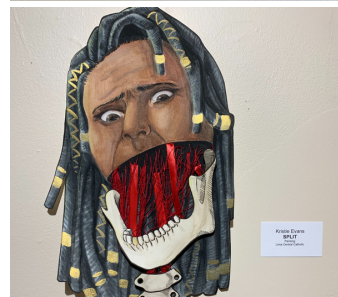
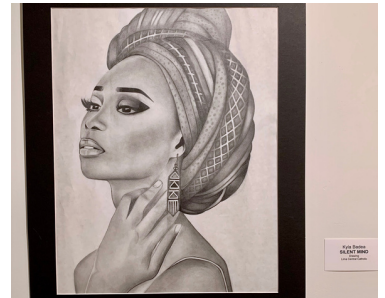
Spanish 1 Art
