<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pants, shorts, skirts - worn at the waist/beltline; Dresses</li> <li>• All bottom wear must be within 2-3 inches of the top of knee or lower</li> <li>• Pants must be correct fit/size</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sagging (pants worn below the waist)</li> <li>• Sweatpants/Joggers</li> <li>• Basketball shorts/Athletic Wear</li> <li>• Leggings without skirt or tunic (long shirt)</li> <li>• Skin showing above the knee length requirement</li> <li>• Fishnet stockings</li> </ul>
Acceptable Footwear	Not Acceptable Pants, Skirts, Dresses and Bottoms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tennis shoes, dress shoes, boots</li> <li>• Fastened sandals in front and back</li> <li>• Laced and strapped shoes fastened as designed</li> <li>• Heels under 2 inches.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Flip-flops, slides, unfastened and unsecured shoes</li> <li>• Heels over 2 inches</li> <li>• Open toed shoes without a strap across the back</li> <li>• Physical Education - shoes other than athletic shoes</li> </ul>
Acceptable Accessories	Not Acceptable Items
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Purses smaller than a textbook</li> <li>• Simple barrettes, bows, headbands, ponytail or braid restraints</li> <li>• Book bags must be kept in locker</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bandanas, non-religious head coverings, do-rags/du-rags, bonnets</li> <li>• Sunglasses</li> <li>• Oversized jewelry</li> <li>• Hair brushes, combs, sponges &amp; picks in class</li> <li>• Nail polish and scented sprays/lotions items (due to medical reasons)</li> </ul>
