Statement of Purpose and Intent

Drug use of any kind is incompatible with participation in extracurricular activities on behalf of USD 480. For the safety and wellbeing of the students involved in extracurricular activities, USD 480 has adopted a Student Drug Testing Policy.

Consent of Testing

By signing this consent form, the student and parent/guardian consent to the student providing a sample of urine under the conditions stated in the Drug Testing Policy by random selection. The sample shall be tested for illegal substances. No student shall be allowed to practice or participate in any extracurricular activity or program until the student and the student's parent or legal guardian have signed and returned this consent.

We, the undersigned student and parent/guardian, have read the USD 480 Athletic/Activities Policy. We have read the Drug Testing Policy and this Student Athletic/Activities Drug Testing Consent form. We understand the Drug Testing Policy and this consent form and further understand that if the undersigned student violates the Drug Testing Policy, the student will be subject to the consequences provided in the Drug Testing Policy.

We, the undersigned student and parent/guardian understand, agree and consent to the following:

- 1. The requirements and procedures specified and set forth in the Student Drug Testing Policy and all other aspects of the Student Drug Testing Program.
- 2. As a condition to the student's participation in extracurricular activities and programs offered by USD 480, the student will be subjected to the terms of the Drug Testing Policy and this Consent form.
- 3. The list of medications and other medical information submitted to USD 480 by the student under the Drug Testing Policy may be given to the company which is performing the drug testing for USD 480.
- 4. The company performing the drug testing for USD 480 may provide to USD 480 the results of the testing as provided in the Drug Testing Policy and discuss with USD 480 personnel the results of such test.

USD 480 ATHLETIC/ACTIVITIES POLICY

THIS POLICY IS IN EFFECT FROM THE FIRST DAY OF FALL ATHLETIC PRACTICE EACH SCHOOL YEAR UNITL THE CONCLUSION OF SPRING SPORTS. STUDENTS WILL BE HELD ACCOUNTABLE TO THESE GUIDELINES DURING AND OUTSIDE THEIR SEASON OF COMPETITION.

In order for a student at Liberal High School to be involved in athletics/activities, he/she must abide by these USD 480 guidelines as well as those established by the Kansas State High School Activities Association.

TOBACCO USE

First Offense

*Loss of 10% of the regular season's participation. Loss of participation will begin immediately after the incident and will continue in order of contests played.

*Perform 10 hours of community service. The project needs to be approved by the head coach/sponsor and Athletic Director and shall be completed within thirty (30) days from the date of the incident. These community service hours do not count toward required community service hours for graduation.

Second Offense

*Loss of 20% of the regular season's participation. Loss of participation will begin immediately after the incident and will continue in order of contests played.

*Perform 12 hours of community service. The project needs to be approved by the head coach/sponsor and Athletic Director and shall be completed within thirty (30) days from the date of the incident. These community service hours do not count toward required community service hours for graduation.

Third Offense

*Suspended for 365 consecutive days from the date of incident.

*Perform 15 hours of community service. The project needs to be approved by the head coach/sponsor and Athletic Director and shall be completed within thirty (30) days from the date of the incident. These community service hours do not count toward required community service hours for graduation.

ALCOHOL/ILLEGAL DRUGS

First Offense

*Loss of 20% of the regular season's participation. Loss of participation will begin immediately after the incident and will continue in order of contests played.

*Perform 10 hours of community service. The project needs to be approved by the head coach/sponsor and Athletic Director and shall be completed within thirty (30) days from the date of the incident. These community service hours do not count toward required community service hours for graduation.

*Drug Education. You must enroll within 14 days of the incident in a Drug Education program approved by the Athletic Director. The drug education program will be at the individual's expense. You must be enrolled and actively participating in the approved drug education program to continue participation in your activity. Proof of completion must be submitted in writing to the Athletic Director

Second Offense

*Suspended for the next 365 days from participation in athletics/activities.

*Perform 15 hours of community service. The project needs to be approved by the head coach/sponsor and Athletic Director and shall be completed within thirty (30) days from the date of the incident. These community service hours do not count toward required community service hours for graduation.

*Drug Education. You must enroll within 14 days of the incident in an approved Drug Education program. The drug education program will be at the individual's expense. You must be enrolled and actively participating in the approved drug education program to continue participation in your activity. Proof of completion must be submitted in writing to the Athletic Director. Proof of completion must be submitted in writing to the Athletic Director. Proof of completion must be submitted in writing to the Athletic Director. In the event a Student is suspended for a violation of this policy pertaining to illegal drugs, before the Student is reinstated, a full screen drug test must be submitted to the Athletic Director. The drug test will be at the Student's expense and obtained from a facility approved by the School District. If the drug test is negative, the Student will be allowed to resume Extracurricular Activities. If the drug test is positive, it shall be deemed a separate violation of this policy, to be dealt with as provided for in this Policy.

We, the student and parent, have read and understand this policy. This from must be returned by all students prior to participation in athletics and activities at Liberal High School.

*BOE/USD 480 school policies and consequences listed within them will supersede this policy as it relates to violations during school athletic/activity sponsored events and/or on school property.
