INTEGRATION AND DESEGREGATION

BOARD POLICY:

It is the policy of the Board of Education that there shall be no discrimination because of race, color, religion, sex, or national origin in the placement, instruction, and guidance of pupils; the employment, assignment, training, or promotion of personnel; the provision and maintenance of physical supplies and equipment; the development and implementation of the curriculum, including the activities program; and in all matters relating to instruction, supervision, administration, and board policy making.

Implemental Procedures:

1. Community cooperation is believed to be essential in that residential patterns, as well as cultural and social attitudes of the people, have an impact on segregation. The Board of Education sees the public school system as an agency to give leadership in developing attitudes and understandings which are compatible to a democratic society.
2. The Board of Education will adopt specific plans and procedures to provide for an integrated school system.
3. The board will cooperate with other agencies in their efforts to work with problems associated with integration and desegregation in the community.
