POLICY OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

POLICY CONCERNING STUDENT JACKETS WAS REVIEWED AND DISCUSSED AT LENGTH.

Mr. Gibbs moved the quality and kind of jackets we now have remain the standard junior high all cloth, senior high cloth with leather sleeves, and if possible change the color of the leather sleeves to blue if special color does not cost more than three dollars extra per sleeve. The jackets for band, athletics, and all other be the same style and quality. Grades ten and eleven students may purchase their own jacket exactly like the senior jacket and after meeting all requirements their senior year the recipient may elect to receive a new jacket or reimbursement for the one purchased. Coaches are to buy their own jacket but after completing three consecutive years may receive a new jacket or be reimbursed for the purchased jacket.

Mr. Patterson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

The Board further agreed that the dollar figure limitation be removed from the policy. The superintendent is to compare prices and/or bids to find and accept the lowest and/or best bid.
