

SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION

FEBRUARY 1984

Re: Letter Jackets

I recommend the policy remain the same in regard to letter jackets; as to who will letter, seniors, etc.

However, I recommend a vendor be located in Miami who can furnish a jacket specified by the Board at a pre-determined price and allow each student to purchase his own jacket.

Seniors:

The Board should set a dollar maximum, allow the senior to purchase own jacket and if he wants extras, that would be between him and the vendor.

A list of qualified senior lettermen will be presented to the principal's office and to the vendor so there will be no question as to who qualifies for what.

Example:

Base price for jacket and letter	\$75.00
Johnny Doe: Inserts FB TR BB @ \$5.00 ea	<u>10.00</u>
Total allowed for J. Doe	85.00
